

WORD OF LIFE

10th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Do Not Blaspheme

"Amen, I say to you, all sins and all blasphemies that people utter will be forgiven them. But whoever blasphemes against the holy Spirit will never have forgiveness, but is guilty of an everlasting sin." For they had said, "He has an unclean spirit." Jesus and His Family, His mother and his brothers arrived. Standing outside they sent word to him and called him. A crowd seated around him told him, "Your mother and your brothers [and your sisters] are outside asking for you." But he said to them in reply, "Who are my mother and [my] brothers?" And looking around at those seated in the circle he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. [For] whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

(Mark 3: 28-35)

What did Jesus mean when he said that blasphemy against the Holy Spirit would not be forgiven? From the evangelical text, it is deduced that he was referring to those who said that He was possessed by an unclean spirit or, in other words, that He was not the Son of God but of the devil. Since His conception was the fruit of the Holy Spirit, by saying this, He was blaspheming against the third person of the Holy Trinity, even though the person who did so was not aware of it.

But there was something else. The Blessed Virgin, His Mother, was also being insulted. In fact, the evangelical text speaks about it below. To say that Jesus is not the Son of God or that He was not conceived by the Holy Spirit, respecting the virginity of Mary, but that He was conceived by a man -- Saint Joseph or another -- is a blasphemy that, the Lord warns, will not be forgiven.

But it is not enough to not offend the Spirit or Mary. We must defend them. We must defend the divine paternity of Jesus and the innocence, purity and perpetual virginity of Mary. It will be a peaceful defense in the face of so much blasphemy, but it should never be a silence by omission which smacks of cowardice.

Purpose: Pray the Rosary daily in reparation of so many offenses that the Virgin suffers. Invoke the Holy Spirit to give you the strength to be a defender of God.

PALABRA DE VIDA

Domingo X del tiempo ordinario No blasfemes

"Yo os aseguro que se perdonará todo a los hijos de los hombres, los pecados y las blasfemias, por muchas que éstas sean. Pero el que blasfeme contra el Espíritu Santo, no tendrá perdón nunca, antes bien, será reo de pecado eterno." Es que decían: «Está poseído por un espíritu inmundo.» Llegan su madre y sus hermanos, y quedándose fuera, le envían a llamar. Estaba mucha gente sentada a su alrededor. Le dicen: «¡Oye!, tu madre, tus hermanos y tus hermanas están fuera y te buscan.» Él les responde: «¿Quién es mi madre y mis hermanos?» Y mirando en torno a los que estaban sentados en corro, a su alrededor, dice: «Estos son mi madre y mis hermanos. Quien cumpla la voluntad de Dios, ése es mi hermano, mi hermana y mi madre». (Mc 3, 28-35)

¿A qué se refería Jesús al decir que la blasfemia contra el Espíritu Santo no sería perdonada? Del texto evangélico se deduce que se refería a los que decían que estaba poseído por un espíritu inmundo o, lo que es lo mismo, que no era Hijo de Dios sino del demonio. Al decir esto, como su concepción fue fruto del Espíritu Santo, se estaba blasfemando contra la tercera persona de la Santísima Trinidad, aunque el que lo hiciera no fuera consciente de ello.

Pero había algo más. También se estaba insultando a la Santísima Virgen, su Madre. De hecho, el texto evangélico habla de ella a continuación. Decir que Jesús no es Hijo de Dios o que no fue concebido por el Espíritu Santo respetando la virginidad de María, sino que fue concebido por un hombre - San José u otro-, es una blasfemia que, advierte el Señor, no será perdonada.

Pero no basta con no ofender al Espíritu ni a María. Hay que defenderlos. Hay que defender la paternidad divina de Jesús y la inocencia, pureza y virginidad perpetua de María. Será una defensa pacífica ante tanta blasfemia, pero no debe ser nunca silencio por omisión que huele a cobardía.

Propósito: Rezar el Rosario diariamente, en desagravio por tantas ofensas que sufre la Virgen. Invocar al Espíritu Santo para que nos dé la fuerza de ser defensores de Dios.


