Requirements for Baptism

- 1. Baptisms are celebrated on Saturday according to the Parish. *Talk to the secretary to see dates available.
- 2. Register in person at the Parish Office; at least one month prior to the baptism.
- 3. Fill out the Baptism application form with all the required information at the parish office with two weeks in advance.
- 4. Parents and godparents must attend to Pre-Baptismal class. (They will receive a certificate stating that they have already received their pre-Baptismal class.)
- 5. If the parents are **NOT** parishioners of our Parish or are coming from another state, they <u>**MUST**</u> bring a permission from the Pastor from their local Parish where they live.
- 6. All paperwork <u>**MUST BE</u>** submitted to the parish office <u>**ON THE TIME**</u> stablished by the secretary, otherwise the Baptism cannot be celebrated.</u>

7. **REQUIREMENTS TO BE A GODPARENT:**

- Be at least 16 years of age
- Have received the 3 Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation)
- Be practicing the Catholic faith (Sunday Mass, and Holy day of Obligations).
- Can be a single godparent or a single godmother or both. (If two, it must be a woman and a man **Catholic**).
- The godparents can be two single people Catholic, not living in a common-law marriage and living in chastity and their Catholic faith.
- If married, they **MUST** be married in the Catholic Church.
- If the godparents are living with someone, they **MUST BE** married in the Catholic Church, even if only he/she is the godparent.
- If the godparents come from out of state, they must send a certified letter with two weeks in advance from their Parish stating that they have already taken the Baptism preparation and formation class.
- 8. Our Parish does **NOT** have a fee for the celebration of the Sacraments, but we ask for a voluntary offering (The amount you wish) for the Parish, please turn in one week prior to the Baptism in a sealed envelope directly to the Parish Secretary.

(This donation is to help our Parish with all the expenses of light, electricity, office, talks, etc. please be generous).

- 9. If you wish to donate a freewill offering for the Priest (any amount you wish) give it to him personally on the day of the Baptism in a sealed envelope.
- 10. Parents and godparents are reminded to be **<u>ON TIME</u>** on the day of the Baptism.
